Dolphin Competition

Our initial thinking around the Dolphin Competition, consistent with previous years, is to structure the programme to minimise the time the Dolphins have to spend at Nationals. The proposal (subject to entries) is to hold the Dolphin Figures as the last Figures session on Sunday – so clubs could possibly fly in on Sunday morning (subject to flight schedules). Music practise for Dolphins would be on the Sunday afternoon with the Dolphin Combo event on Monday morning and prize giving held within the Solo scheduling – to enable clubs to fly their Dolphins out that afternoon after lunch.

We know it is difficult to plan flights at this stage as Covid is still impacting flight schedules, but hopefully this will allow greater certainty with planning.

Call for Indication of Accommodation Requirements

An Indication of Accommodation Requirements form will be sent mid -March (deadline end March for completion) to enable us to understand your accommodation requirements.

We have currently block-booked Southland Girls' Hostel and Southland Boys' Hostels for Athletes' Accommodation (190 beds).

We are also working with the Invercargill Licensing Trust on further accommodation options for teams and Judges, and hope to pencil in bookings for Motels and other accommodation options to ensure there is sufficient accommodation reserved while we work through this.

Call for Preliminary Entries

Call for Preliminary Entries (Google sheets) will be sent out to all clubs by Karen Moffatt-McLeod at ASNZ in early April - deadline for completion May 31st.

Call for Judges

Call for Judges will be sent at the same time (with the same deadline), where we will be asking Clubs to provide Judges' names, mobile numbers and email addresses for the event – summarised on a separate form that will be sent with the Preliminary Entries.

Judges' Requirements:

 All participating clubs are asked to provide judges on the ratio of one fully available judge for every 6 swimmers.

Merchandise	 For example, if your Club has 36 athletes competing you will need to provide 6 Judges. If you have more judges than your ratio who wish to come, please include their names too, as other clubs who don't have enough judges may choose to fund them to meet their commitments We request that all Judges are fully available for the whole event and confirmation of this requirement will be required on the forms Artistic Swimming NZ is moving towards not having coaches/ judges from this year. International teams (dependent on Covid 19 Restrictions) would be required to bring judges based on the New Zealand Club ratio of 1:6. Indicative Entry Fees

Event fee: \$70 per competitor

Photos: \$30 per competitor (compulsory)

Figures: \$20 per age group

Routines: \$25 per swimmer per event

Schools: \$5 for all Soloists/Duets wanting to be considered for School awards

Entry fees will be finalised after receipt of preliminary entries. Entry fees are applicable to all swimmers, including any reserves named for Solo, Duet, Team and Combination events.

Pool Information

The competition will take place at Splash Palace, Invercargill Swimmers will enter the water at the 15m wide edge and judges will sit on either side of the 23m long length of the pool.



During competition, a clear deck policy will apply and only those with official accreditation will be allowed on the pool deck. During each routine, the coach(es) of the competing team will have access to the deck for viewing purposes only.
