Judging Weekends	Judging will occur over the following weekends – with all results kept 100% confidential until the livestream. Timetable to be confirmed over those weekends • 20 th /21 st November – Figures • 27 th /28 th November – Routines
Streaming of the Competition	The competition will be Livestreamed on the following weekend (when NCEA is almost over). Clubs are asked to host events in their own town so athletes can watch the competition, see the scores and receive their medals. Timetable to be confirmed. • 11 th /12 th December 2021

Coordinating Your Pool	 Each club is required to Work through pool bookings and timetabling of filming. We do understand that for some clubs this may be challenging where pools have different Level 2 rules.
Coordinating Your Videographer	 Each club is required to Identify who will be their videographer Videos must be done from digital video cameras - not lpads. Your videographer should be either professional or technically savvy individual with proven ability to run a video camera, able to drop music onto the routine video (better quality than recording the atmospheric pool sound) and be accomplished at uploading all files to ASNZ on Dropbox. Specific information for Videographers is provided later in this Bulletin.

Please note - they will not be required over the whole weekend, but we cannot confirm the timetable until we know the final entries. We do need as many judges as possible to ensure that this competition is a success, and the expectation is still that Clubs provide judges on the 1:6 ratio. Judge Education SAVE THIS DATE	2 October - Judges Education Forum (Time TBC - Z00M Session) Compulsory for all judges. Note this is the equivalent of the first day education at Nationals.
Meeting Dates for Videographer SAVE THESE DATES	2 October - Videographer Briefing this is vital your videographer attends this Zoom session. Time TBC
	17 October - Test Video to be submitted - Videographers will be asked to submit a test video of Figures and Routine filmed at the pool venue where filming will take place at the same time, so video can be reviewed by the Meet Referee (or representative). Note - filexibility to be given for Auckland clubs if required
Figures Draw	The Figures Draw for 12 & Under and 13/14/15 Figures will be done on 21st October. Please note, the same Figures will be used for Virtual Nationals and Squad Trials. The deadline for Squad Trials is earlier, because we need to know successful Squad triallists ASAP, so we can

	book flights and make arrangements for December and January camps. Clubs can choose to use the same video for Squad Trials and competition entry if they wish, or to record two separate videos for submission if they prefer. The following two figures have been selected in advance for the non competitive groups - one compulsory and one optional as follows: • Dolphins - Sailboat Alternate and Somersault Front Pike • Aquarinas - Rio and Jupiter • Aquanuants - Barracuda and Walkover Back

Get your Music Ready	Ensure it is of a high quality - make sure your videographer can overlay this over the routine before uploading.
Pre Run Through and film as a back up	As soon as you are back at the pool we suggest that clubs record all your athletes' swims and save them as a back up competition video in case we move alert levels. You do not need to get a videographer for this. We suggest you use an ipad for this recording. This will make sure that if the worst happens you are still able to submit something for the competition.

Coordinating 2 Timekeepers per club for Routine Judging Weekend

Timekeepers will be required to timekeep for all routines over the Judging Weekend (27/28 November). Timekeepers will....

- Watch each routine live streamed at the same time as the judges.
- Record the times of walk-ons and routines as they normally do.
- Communicate any penalties to the Panel Referee at the time.
- Clubs will need to provide the names and details of two timekeepers per club who are available over that weekend. Note

 they will only need to timekeep at some events (as for a normal Face to Face Nationals.

FIGURES

- Out of Auckland by 7th November
- Auckland clubs by 14th November

ROUTINES

- Out of Auckland by 14th November
- Auckland clubs by 21st November
- Clubs have flexibility to define their own timetable subject to pool availability. Note deadlines for clubs out of Auckland are a week earlier to reflect the longer time they will have in the pool.
- Clubs can film as early as they want if they wish, and work together to share filming if they wish.
- We want to ensure fairness and equity for all athletes partaking in this Virtual National, just like we do at a face to face event. Therefore we are...requesting that clubs film the routines only once as per normal competition environment
- To verify that the routine has been only filmed once, there should be either a senior judge/independent judge or a ASNZ Board member present at filming to sign this off.
- Figures to be performed in front of two Club judges who identify if an incorrect figure is performed for Dolphins/Aqua athletes who get a second chance to present figure. Both figures videos to be uploaded so the Figures Referee can review this decision.

REMEMBER TO HAVE VIDEOS OF FIGURES AND ROUTINES SUBMITTED BY MIDNIGHT OF THE LAST ENTRY DAY.

	Clubs confirm timetable to ASNZ and by midnight the day of filming files to be uploaded. Entries that have not been uploaded by the date or time frame will not be accepted.
Collation of Videos for Judging	ASNZ will be collating videos for judging as follows: • Figures - 7-18 November • Routines - 14-24 November
Judging Dates SAVE THESE DATES	 20-21 November Figures Judging - This will be run via Zoom. Process currently being confirmed with advice from Canadian Synchro. 22-23 November - Judges Training to be able to access and use the ISS scoring system when judging the routines sections. Times TBC but this is a very simple short process. The training will support judges creating their log in account, login, watch a video for 5 minutes and enter a score. If judges have trouble, they will email ISS and they will work through any technical issues with the judges. 27-28 November Routine Judging - using the ISS U-Judge System

Prep for Party Celebrations	 Clubs coordinate your social viewing event. Send out Invites to club members Book venues or coordinate a place to watch the live streaming Theme for your club event
Virtual Competition Coming to Clubs via Streaming 11th and 12th December	 Early December We will courier medals/trophies to clubs in a sealed box in advance, so when announcements are made after each event of who gets 1st, 2nd, 3rd - presentations can be made in clubs at the viewing party. December 11-12th Streamed through vimeo.com of routine events only. Figures will not be streamed. We would love clubs to video or share posts on social media of the presentation of medals and cool highlight photos of the clubs viewing parties. ASNZ would then repost and share hype and excitement - like a live competition through the day.

 ASNZ will work with clubs on timetable on when we will stream what events e.g. Dolphins/Aquanauts/Aquarinas one day and Age Group the next so not all athletes have to be there for two days or the whole length of time.

Competition Overview and Guidelines

Figures	Figures have been reduced from four to two for the Dolphins, Aquanauts and Aquarinas. Figures have been confirmed as follows: • Dolphins - Sailboat Alternate and Somersault Front Pike • Aquarinas - Rio and Jupiter • Aquanuants - Barracuda and Walkover Back
	Age Group Figures will continue as usual but draw to be done in advance to reduce stress and increase effectiveness of pool space usage in preparation.
	The Figures Draw will be made on 21 October for 12 Under, 13-14-15 competitive groups. The figures drawn will be the same figures to be presented at Squad Trials.
Competition Rules	 We will be following the National Championships Rules for this event Click Here In regards to STARS We will be lenient for 2021 in regards to athletes not having their right level of stars for the routines they have entered in. We do suggest in 2022 that clubs make Stars a focus to be completed early on in the year and judged ready for competitions. We suggest coaches should continue to present routines as though judges are on both sides of the pool.
Entry Fees	There will be no competition entry fees for NZ athletes from ASNZ - who will use profits from 2021 to fund the cost of the ISS/U-Judge/Event presentation and medals/ribbons, , leaving clubs to pick up the costs for your Videographer and Pool Hire. Clubs can

	choose how to fund this i.e. spread across your club competitors or paid for out of club funds.
International Entries	Depending on the availability of judges and New Zealand entries, we may be in a position to invite international entries. A decision will be made on this by mid October. There will be an entry fee for international entries.
